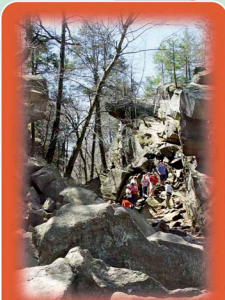
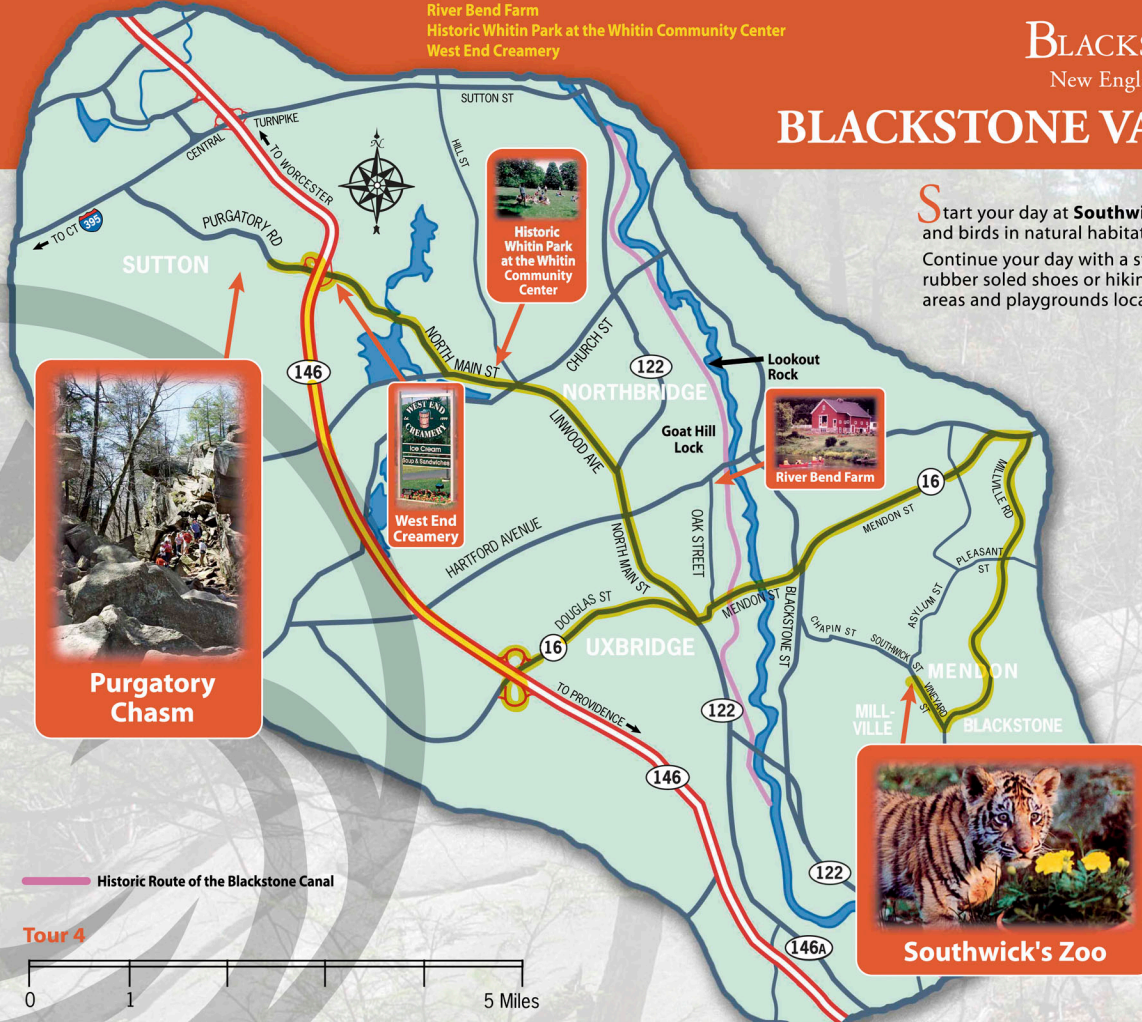
Start your day at **Southwick's Zoo**, New England's largest. Enjoy the zoo's 300 acres of animals and birds in natural habitat settings. Enjoy a picnic or visit the Zebra Cafe for lunch. Continue your day with a stop at **Purgatory Chasm State Reservation**. Be sure to wear your rubber soled shoes or hiking boots for exploring the fine trails of this gorge. Also visit the picnic areas and playgrounds located in the majestic pines at the Chasm.

Directions from Southwick's Zoo to Purgatory Chasm State Reservation:
 From the Zoo parking lot, turn right onto Southwick St. which changes to Vineyard St. At Millville Rd. turn left. Continue to Route 16 where you will turn left. Follow the signs to Route 146 North. From 146 North, exit at Purgatory Rd. Turn left at the bottom of the off ramp.

Directions from Purgatory Chasm State Reservation to Southwick's Zoo:
 Follow Purgatory Rd. which turns into North Main St. At intersection bear right to Linwood St. Make a right onto Route 122 (now North Main St. in Uxbridge.) Continue to downtown Uxbridge, turn left onto Route 16 and follow east on Mendon St. and turn right at the sign for Southwick's Zoo onto Millville Rd. Continue 4 miles and turn right at the Southwick's Zoo sign at Vineyard St.

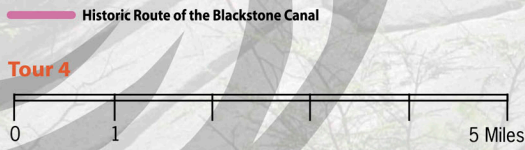
